- 1. According to terms of applicable provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 members may send their assent or dissent in writing on the Postal Ballot Form.
- 2. Members who have not registered their e-mail addresses with the Company are being sent this Postal Ballot Form along with the Notice of Postal Ballot, and self-addressed envelope bearing name of scrutinizer through Courier.
- 3. A member desiring to exercise his/her vote by Postal Ballot Form should complete this Postal Ballot Form, sign and send in the enclosed self-addressed postage pre-paid envelope so as to reach the Scrutinizer as per instruction 6 below at the address: Mr. S.K. Agrawal, The Scrutinizer, Studds Accessories Limited 23/7 Mathura Road Ballabgarh Faridabad, Haryana-121004. Postage will be borne and paid by the Company. Envelopes containing Postal Ballots, if deposited in person or sent by courier at the expenses of members will be accepted.
- 4. The Postal Ballot Form should be completed and signed by the Members. In case of joint share holding, this form should be completed and signed by the first named Member and in his/her absence, by the next named Member(s). Unsigned Postal Ballot Forms will be rejected.
